

Riff Yeager – Assistant Age Group/Junior & Senior Coach

Riff began his coaching with BAC in the spring of 2011. He brings 15 years of previous coaching experience ranging from Age Group to College. His primary focus at BAC is coaching our senior swimmers in Shakopee with also coaching some of our Age Group/Junior Team swimmers.

He also has been a high school coach and country club coach at Wayzata and Woodhill for a combined 9 years.

He finished his collegiate swim career and graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire. He was a Minnesota High School State Champion and State Record-Holder in the 50 Freestyle, along with being a High School All-American.
